Instructions:

1. There are three listening activities in section A and three speaking activities in section B. Students can do any one from each section: one from listening and one from speaking.

2. Testing Listening

- Listening Activity में बच्चों को सुनकर खाली स्थान भरना, शब्दों को गोला लगाना या सही/गलत का निशान लगाना जैसे कार्य करने को कहें।
- शिक्षक गतिविधि की exercise को बोर्ड पर लिख दें एवं बच्चों को एक कागज पर उतारने के लिए कहें।
- उसके बाद शिक्षक passage को तीन बार पढ़ें – पहली बार बच्चे केवल सुनें, दूसरी बार बच्चे दिया हुआ कार्य करें, तीसरी बार बच्चे उत्तरों की जांच करें एवं जो छूट गया है उसे पूर्ण करें।
- बच्चों से कागज वापस लेकर उसकी जांच करें।

(Note - जांच करते समय इस बात का ध्यान रखें कि गलत spelling पर अंक नहीं काटने हैं क्योंकि यह गतिविधि बच्चों की सुनने की दक्षता को जांचने के लिए करवाई जा रही है।)

3. Testing Speaking

मौखिक अभिव्यक्ति कौशल में pronunciation, stress, intonation, pause, grammar, word choice आदि बातें शामिल होती हैं। शिक्षक इस बात का ध्यान रखें कि हमारा मुख्य उद्देश्य यह जांचना है कि बच्चे बिना झिझक के 5-6 वाक्य धाराप्रवाह बोल पा रहे हैं या नहीं। अतः यदि वे थोड़ी-बहुत गलतियां कर रहे हैं और हमें उनकी बात समझ में आ रही है तो उच्चारण (pronunciation) एवं व्याकरण (grammar) की गलतियों पर ध्यान न दें।
