राज्य शैक्षिक अनुसंधान और प्रशिक्षण परिषद् छत्तीसगढ़ शंकर नगर, रायपुर वर्तमान में शालाओं में आकलन की प्रक्रिया को और अधिक प्रभावशाली बनाने तथा शिक्षकों और छात्रों में विषयों की समझ को अधिक विकसित करने से लिए अच्छे प्रश्नों का निर्माण होना आवश्यक है।

इस उद्देश्य की पूर्ति के लिए SCERT द्वारा पाठ्यक्रम के आधार पर प्रश्न बैंक का निर्माण किया गया है। प्रश्न बैंक के माध्यम से शिक्षण अधिगम संबंधी उद्देश्यों की पूर्ति की जा सकती है। शिक्षक इसका उपयोग पढ़ाने, परीक्षा लेने तथा छात्र स्वआकलन के लिए कर सकते है।


